**ACADEMIC SENATE** 1 2 Resolution 19/20-05 3 4 Review of the Office of Conduct, Accountability and Professionalism (OCAP) 5 6 WHEREAS a number of faculty members have expressed grave concerns regarding the practices and procedures of the recently established Office of Conduct, Accountability, and 7 8 Professionalism (OCAP), which has jurisdiction over "egregious complaints, such as hostile 9 work environment or violence in the workplace," that fall outside the normal process for 10 reviewing allegations of faculty misconduct and are not the responsibility of the university offices charged with upholding legally mandated obligations (such as the Title IX office, the 11 12 Office of Equity and Diversity, and the various administrative entities that oversee 13 regulatory compliance); 14 15 WHEREAS these concerns are exacerbated by the opaque process by which OCAP itself 16 was created: 17 18 WHEREAS the handling of similar complaints against staff members can also raise 19 concerns: 20 21 WHEREAS the President and Provost have recognized that changes must be made in 22 OCAP's practices, procedures, and jurisdiction; and 23 24 WHEREAS the imposition of sanctions on faculty and staff members for allegedly 25 egregious behavior is a very serious matter, in which the faculty and staff legitimately have 26 a substantial interest: 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED that the Academic Senate recommends: 29 30 1. That the President appoint a committee, which shall include members chosen by 31 the Academic Senate and Staff Assembly, to work with the Senior Vice President for 32 Human Resources to recommend a set of responsibilities, procedures, and standards for the 33 administrative unit(s) that will have authority to investigate and adjudicate allegations of 34 faculty and staff misbehavior or other transgressions that fall outside the jurisdiction of the 35 other university offices charged with upholding the university's legally mandated 36 responsibilities; and 37 38 2.
